POSITION SUMMARY

The NextGen Intern assists in the planning, implementation, and administration of all facets of the SV Kids and SV Students ministry at Sun Valley Community Church throughout the year. Strategic areas of ministry include Weekend Programming, Weekly Meetings, Summer Spectacular, Camps, Targeted Outreach and Discipleship Initiatives. This is a 15 hours/week position, for those with high school or college experience and ministry as their future career. In all actions they reflect the SV team leadership distinctives.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Attends and participates in weekly campus staff team meetings.
2. Attends a weekly Sun Valley Community Church weekend service.
3. Takes a significant role in weekend ministry programming such as scheduling, hosting, worship etc.
4. Meets with staff and leaders to understand the function and role of all staff positions.
5. Establishes healthy relationships with both parents, children and students.
6. Completes required reading, leadership cohort and SVCC culture orientation.
7. Attends Summer Spectacular, 456 Camp and Student Camp.
8. Assist in the development of leaders in SV Kids and SV Students.
9. Provides care for volunteers/leaders by making phone calls and sending notes.
10. Contacts volunteers weekly through phone calls, emails, and notes in order to provide encouragement.
