The Bible tells us how much God loves us and many other amazing truths. Saying Yes to Jesus is the most important decision you will ever make!

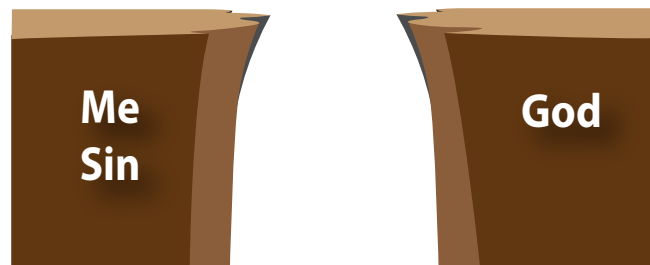


GOD LOVES YOU

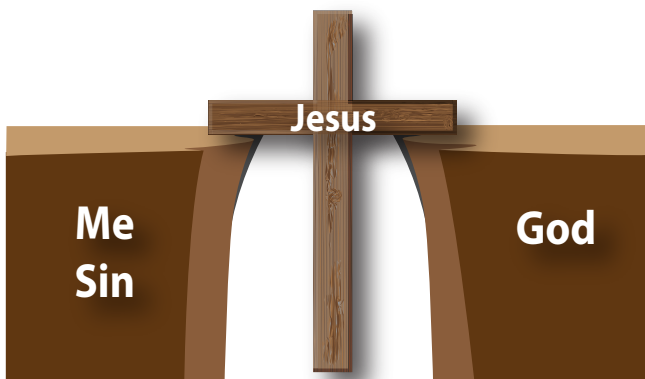

GOD IS FOR YOU

Jesus came to Earth and lived a perfect life. When He chose to die on the cross, He paid the price for our sin, and showed us how much He loves us. After three days, Jesus came back to life and proved that not even death can separate us from the love of God.

Baptism

(Matthew 3:13-17)

Widen The Circle - Pursue strategic relationships for your kids.

At Sun Valley, we believe that relationships are important! While a parent is the most important influence, families need other adults supporting them and speaking truth into their lives. Sometimes it takes another voice to say the same things you are saying to your kid(s) about the essential things in life—just in a different way.

Think through family members, babysitters, teachers, coaches, your small group, friends’ parents, small group leaders. **Who are the people who already have an influence in your child’s life?**
If you can’t think of anyone currently in yours or your child’s life, who can you begin to build a relationship with?

Think and pray about additional people to add to your support system. Start with a list of people you admire or want to get to know better. Then be bold and make the first move. Here are a couple of ways to get started:

- Have a family game night and invite a few people you want to get to know.
- Volunteer in your child’s classroom or sports team and build rapport with their teachers and coaches.
- Invite your child’s Small Group Leader to dinner.
- Ask a trusted babysitter, Small Group Leader or another young adult in your life to attend your child’s game, concert, or play.
- Ask someone with a skill your child wants to learn to teach them something about it.

Ask yourself this question: When my child won’t/can’t talk with me about something, which adult in their lives would they go to that represents our same family values?

Imagine the end - Focus your priorities on what matters most.

We know it’s easy to get caught up in all the day-to-day tasks involved with parenting. It will always be harder to be intentional with your kids than to “go with the flow.” In the midst of life, focus on this simple truth: nothing is more important than your child’s faith. Nothing is more important than living a life that shows your child that God created them, loves them, and desperately wants a relationship with them.

So instead of asking yourself what you want your child to do, what if you asked yourself, who do I want my child to be?
