FIVE FINGER PRAYER

WHAT YOU NEED:

Five Finger prayer printable and crayons

WHAT YOU DO:

Have your child color each of the fingers, one at a time.

WHAT YOU SAY:

As they color the thumb, tell your child that the thumb reminds us to pray for those closest to us. Take a moment, and pray for your family and friends. As they color the "pointer" finger, tell them this reminds us to pray for those who point us in the right direction. Take a moment to pray for teachers, pastors, police officers, etc. As they color the middle finger, tell your child this is the tallest finger, and reminds us to pray for those in authority over us. Take some time to pray for our leaders. The ring finger is our weakest finger! Pause to pray for those who are sick, in poverty, or others you know who are struggling. The pinky, our smallest finger, is to remind us to put our own needs last. This is the time to pray for your individual needs.

PRAYER

"Dear God, we want to tell You how amazing and powerful and loving You are. Even though we can't see You, we know You are real because we see ALL the things You made. I especially want to thank You that I can talk to you anytime, anywhere, for any reason. I know You love all of us with a super big love because You gave us Jesus to be our friend forever. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."
