Summary

The ups and downs of an actual relationship are far more rich than the superficial offering of porn. It is crucial that we guard our characters and pursue virtue. These means having wise personal boundaries, relying on the Holy Spirit, and being in community with people who can keep us accountable. But overcoming sexual sin is hard and we often fail. Never forget that God loves you, no matter how often you repeat the same sins. He never gives up on you or stops being your advocate.
