**To truly oppose porn, we need to understand that sex is part of God's good plan for humanity.**

### Summary

God's vision for sexuality is more lovely and desirable than our perversion of it. Our relational God made us in His image, and He gave us the gift of marriage. Through marriage comes new life, as well as the opportunity for sexual and relational fulfillment. The problem comes when we idolize sex and fall into temptation—as have many of God's followers recorded in the Bible. But the good news is that Jesus has defeated sin and empowers us now to obey Him in every area of our lives.
