Summary

We can define porn as any depiction of sexual activity that causes us to be stimulated erotically. It comes in a variety of media, including music and literature.

While porn is entirely unjustifiable, we need to recognize that the longing for sexual intimacy is a good desire God has given us. Yet millions of people turn to porn because it so powerfully mimics the truth and because it is accessible, affordable, and anonymous.
